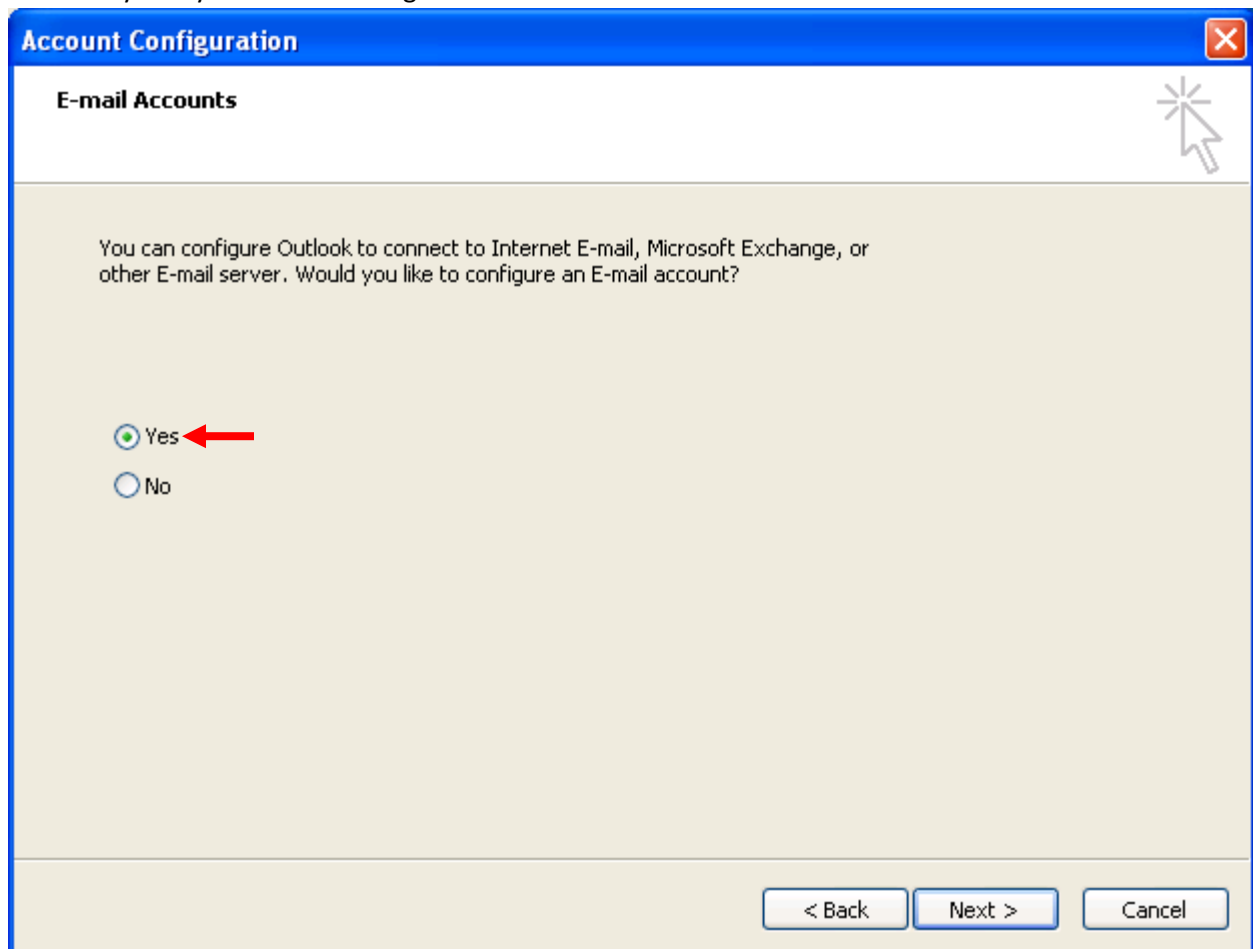


OUTLOOK

Note: These instructions were made using Outlook 2007. Outlook 2010 and 2013 are very similar. People who have Outlook Express should download Windows Live Mail and follow those instructions.

When you first open Outlook, the startup wizard will appear. Click Next. If you are not asked to create an account, you can go to Tools, Account Settings. Under the e-mail tab, click the New button.


It will ask you if you want to configure an e-mail account. Click Yes and Next.





Fill in your name, e-mail address, and password. Click Next.


Add New E-mail Account

Clicking Next will contact your e-mail server and configure your Internet service provider or Microsoft Exchange server account settings.

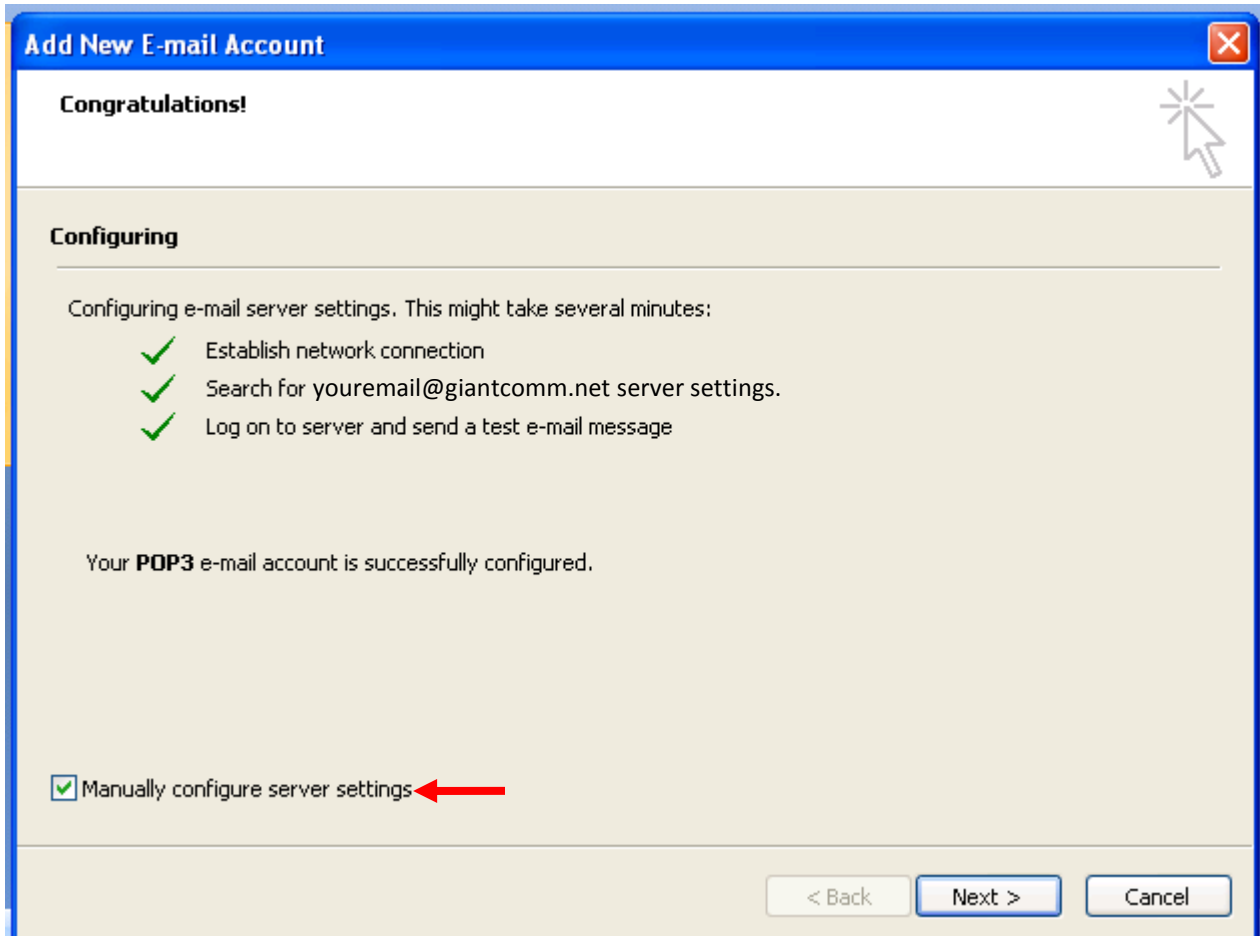

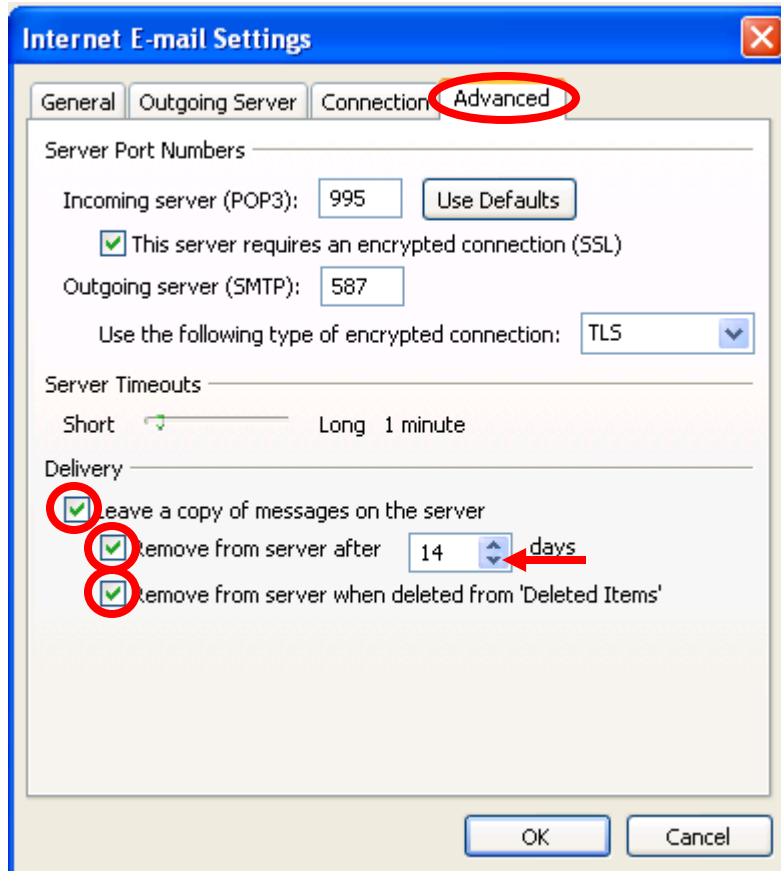
Test Account Settings

Click the Advanced tab. Make sure the following checkboxes are checked:

- "Leave a copy of messages on the server."
- "Remove from the server after __ days"
- "Remove from server when deleted from 'Deleted Items'"

Also, change the number of days a message is kept on the server to 14.
